GERMAN IN THE WORLD OF WORK (MODERN LANGUAGES)

German in Europe:

To understand where German is spoken around the world and its influence on business and employment. How does your knowledge of a subject so incredibly sought after affect your prospects? German at Work:

To show that people do not always have to travel and live or work abroad to use languages in their job through studying a selection of jobs British people do using languages. The purpose of this lesson idea is to make pupils aware of the wide range of jobs that require people to be able to speak different languages, and to move away from the stereotypes of teacher, travel rep etc.

Skills - Interpreter: To learn about a day in the life of an interpreter and to learn about the different forms of interpreting (Consecutive, Conference, Chuchotage) and practise them in class. Focus on working in EU, UN, NATO, business, medicine, law, journalism etc.

	PSHE and CITIZENSHIP Days	Skillls - Translator: To learn about a day in the life of a translator and to learn about the translation in all its forms and practise it. Focus on literary translation, scientific translation, dubbing and subtitling, journalism etc. Goethe Institut: To hear from sixth formers and university students as well as more seasoned individuals who have worked with German around the world and hear about the study and work opportunities available through German. Each class had an individual zoom meeting with a Goethe Representative, involving a presentation, meet and greet and quiz.
