God and has the right to live in peace. Let us not lose hope: let us pray and work tirelessly so that the sense of humanity may prevail over hardness of heart."






Lord, during Lent and the days beyond help us to fast from unkind words and feast on kindness. Help us to fast from jealousy and feast on offering compliments.

Do we fail to forgive others but expect forgiveness?


Remember, Lent offers us an opportunity to make a new start and move closer to God.


